

A developing area: Court-appointed receiverships in Jersey

Collas Crill recently brought <u>a successful</u>, <u>novel application to appoint receivers</u> over a promissory note and reconstitute a breach of a Jersey trust in the context of a bitter international family dispute; the well-publicised Crociani saga.

<u>Sam Williams</u> and <u>Simon Hurry</u>, Group Partners in Collas Crill's Jersey office, respectively brought the application and led a team on behalf of the receivers in worldwide enforcement and recovery proceedings.
